Many units are finding value in adding Work+ to their student job postings, below are various sample descriptions you can include with your postings! Please feel free to find the description that works best for your department and alter it as you see fit.

This position is part of ASU's Work+ program. Participating in Work+ as a working learner, you will complete your day-to-day responsibilities as assigned by your immediate supervisor. As a benefit to being a working learner, you will have paid work time dedicated to developing professional skills and career competencies that will help you in your own career path. This means part of your work responsibilities will be dedicated to developing yourself both personally and professionally.

This position is part of ASU's Work+ program. By participating in Work+, paid work time will be dedicated to developing yourself professionally. Work+ utilizes the 8 career competencies provided by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). These competencies include; leadership, teamwork, communication, critical thinking, equity and inclusion, technology, career and self development, and professionalism. You'll learn about these competencies while developing your professional story, all while preparing yourself for your future career.

This position is part of ASU's Work+ program. Work+ utilizes the 8 NACE career competencies to help prepare you for your future career. You'll develop your professional story while gaining work experience and while financially supporting your college education. Work+ prepares you for careers after graduation by utilizing skills employers are looking for in recent graduates. Paid work time is set aside in your day-to-day tasks for Work+ learning, this means that part of your responsibilities will be dedicated to developing yourself personally and professionally.
